# Hot or Extreme Weather Policy

SADA has a duty of care to ensure the health, comfort and welfare of all members, volunteers, officials, visitors and equine members of the organisation.

## Hot Weather Policy

If the Channel 7 news/weather broadcasts the Friday before a competition/event that the temperature will be 35 °C or over on the competition/event day, the competition/event will be cancelled. Alternatively, the competition/event may start early (e.g., 7 am) and aim to be finished before noon.

### Fire Danger Ratings

If the **Fire Danger Rating** for the **Lewiston** area (**Mid-North**) is **Extreme** or **Catastrophic** for the day of a competition/event, the competition/event will be cancelled. These ratings are published at 4.30 pm on the previous day on the CFS website.

During hot weather rated as **High**, a member of the Committee will be assigned to consult the CFS website hourly for updates to the fire danger rating or the listing of a fire that could potentially impact the grounds or surrounding areas.

### Wet Weather

Wet weather during the preceding week of a competition/event may render the grounds unsuitable for use. The Committee will review the situation with the owner of the grounds and decide on the Friday before if the competition/event should be cancelled.

In all cases, cancellation of a competition/event or alternative arrangements will be published on SADA's website and Facebook page. If possible, an email will also be sent to all competitors.

#### **Extreme Weather**

If extreme weather occurs during a competition/event e.g., wind, rain, hail etc, the Committee may cancel or postpone the competition/event if deemed unsafe for horses, riders, officials, members, volunteers and any other person present. This will be communicated over the PA system.
